10 FACTS ABOUT PERSECUTION Family Research Council - Jan 2021

Christians face severe impediments to the free practice of their faith in many places around the world. As threats to religious freedom mount, it is important to know the challenges believers face around the world. There are 10 facts you need to know about global religious persecution in 2020. Below is a brief summary of each of them. For the next 10 weeks, we will be highlighting these facts in more detail in our bulletin. We hope you will include these threats to religious freedom in your daily prayer time.

Fact #1 More Christians are murdered in Nigeria than in any other country. Fact #2 Covid-19 has enabled religious persecution through relief discrimination, forced conversion, and as justification for increasing surveillance.

Fact #3 Technology is making it easier for governments to control and suppress religious activities.

Fact #4 North Korea has held the title of "world's worst persecutor of Christians" for 20 consecutive years.

Fact #5 Sudan's new constitution guarantees freedom of religion, but it will take time for the situation of Christians to improve.

Fact #6 Approximately 91% of recorded violent killings of Christians for faith-related reasons took place in Africa.

Fact #7 China jumped to #17 on the World Watch List.

Fact #8 Legal harassment of Christians in Turkey has caused some Christians to consider fleeing.

Fact #9 In Latin America, drug cartels are the largest threat to religious freedom. **Fact #10** The world's largest democracy, India, is among the top 10 most difficult countries to be a Christian.

Revive is meeting on Sunday Nights from 6pm-8pm! We have food, fun and a lesson about topics that are relevant to today's teenagers.




