


ICYC is **November 19-21** at Anderson University.

We have 9 students and 2 adults going for this weekend. Please be in prayer for all going that we would have a great weekend and we would grow in our faith.




We have Youth Group Every Sunday Night from 6pm-8pm @ WCC!
