In the month of October we will be talking about **THE TRUTH ABOUT SIN**. We will be learning about how sin can be in our lives, and why it can't be ignored.



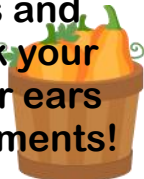
